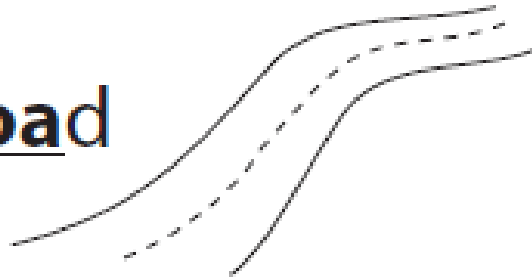


When oe comes at the end of a word, it usually makes a **long o** sound. When oa appears in the middle of a word, it makes a **long o** sound, too.

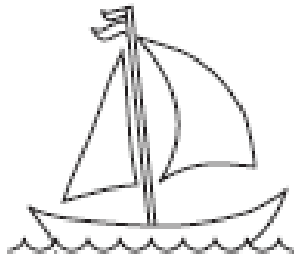
