

L.S.C.W.C Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check each spelling word 4 times.	Sentences Write each spelling word in an interesting sentence. Underline your spelling words.
Hidden Words Find small hidden words in each of your spelling words. Eg: because: be, cause, use	Tricky Parts Circle any silent letters, tricky vowels, double letters etc, in your spelling words. Ask an adult to give you a spelling test.	Rhyming Find two words that rhyme with each of your spelling words.	Syllables Write each of your spelling words and break it into syllables. Remember every syllable has at least 1 vowel (a, e, i, o, u)
Mnemonics A verse or aid to help remember how to spell a word. e.g; a <u>pie</u> ce of <u>pie</u> a fri <u>end</u> to the <u>end</u>	Word Building Add prefixes and/or suffixes to your words to make as many different words as you can. e.g; like – dislike, likeable	Newspaper Art Use magazines or newspapers to make your words. Stick them into your homework book.	Poems Make a poem using your spelling words. You can choose any type of poem e.g; acrostic, limerick
Synonyms Find as many synonyms for each of your spelling words as you can.	Draw Draw your spelling words using boxes. e.g; big 	Word Ladder Make your spelling words form a ladder e.g. MOON E P T U N EARTH	Code Breaker Make your own symbol for each letter of the alphabet and write our each of your spelling words in code.
Bubble Letters Write each of your spelling words in bubble letters and colour them in.	Reverse Order Write all of your spelling words back to front and make a new definition for the word. e.g. frog – gorf gorf – a type of fruit found in South America.	Graffiti Write each of your words in a graffiti style in your spelling book.	Short Story Use each of your spelling words in a short story. Underline each word.
